General Rules and Regulations

5. Safety:

- Prioritize safety by following safety guidelines and instructions provided by the event organizers.
- ❖ The organizer will not be held responsible for the any serious injury.

6. Timing and Scheduling:

- Arrive on time for all events and activities as per the schedule provided by the organizers.
- ❖ Be prepared for any potential changes in the schedule.

7. Fair Play:

- ❖ Adhere to the rules and regulations of the specific sport or activity.
- Refrain from any form of cheating, such as using banned substances or unfair advantages.

8. Disqualification:

Understand that violating the rules or regulations may result in disqualification from the event or penalty.

9. Spectator Rules:

Spectators should also adhere to codes of conduct, such as refraining from disruptive behavior and respecting the decisions of officials.

10. Dispute Resolution:

Follow the event's procedures for addressing disputes or filing complaints.

11. Medical Assistance:

- ❖ Seek immediate medical assistance in case of injuries or medical issues.
